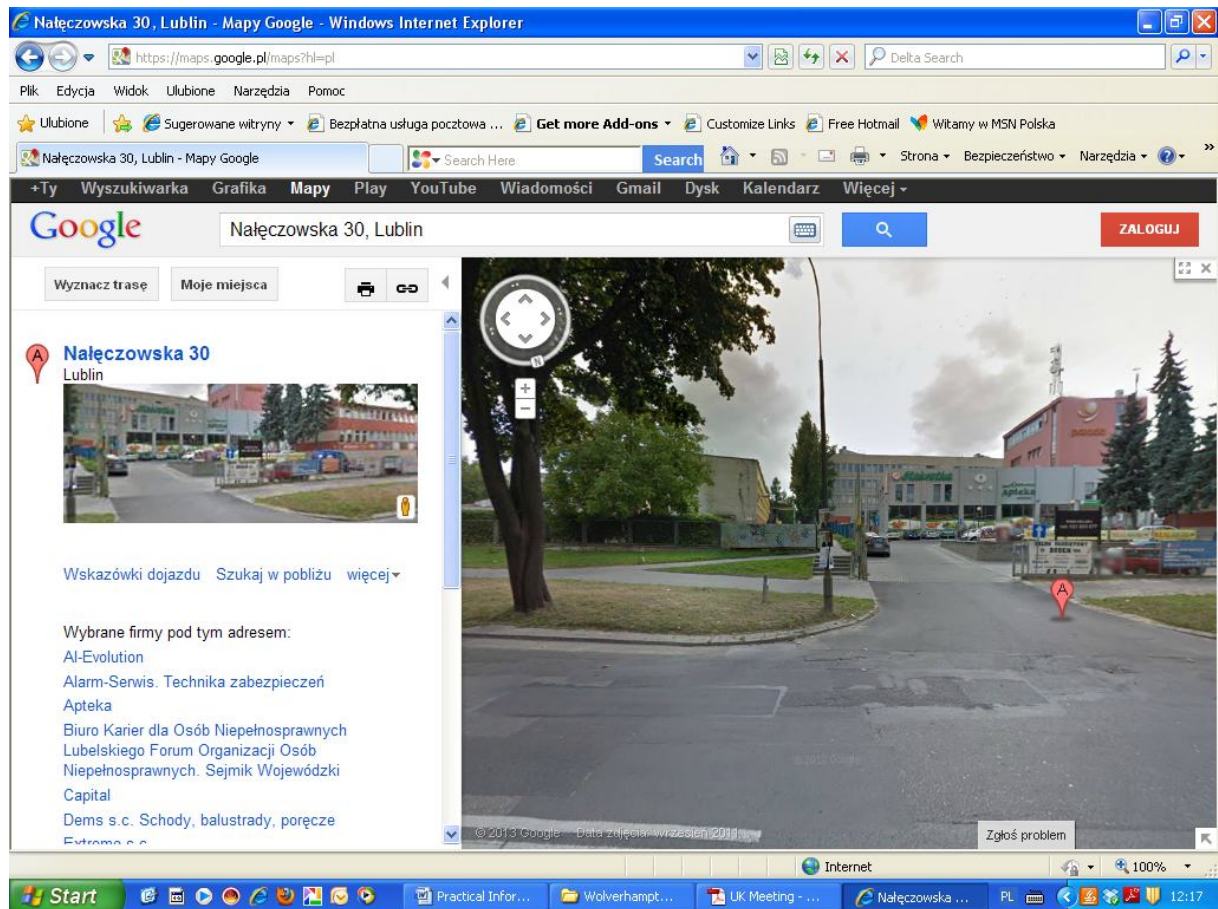

Getting to Lublin

Even though Lublin is proud of its airport since last February, there is still a limited number of connections, and therefore only the Norwegian partners have the possibility to fly directly from Oslo.

From the airport you will need a taxi to your hotel, which should not be more than 15-20 euro.

For other partners, we recommend Warsaw, F.Chopin Airport and then train travel to Lublin (Approx. 2,5 hours).

Important note:

Planning your way to and from Lublin take into consideration train connections Warszawa – Lublin – Warszawa.

In case you arrive or depart very early/late consider staying overnight in Warszawa.

To get from Warsaw Chopin Airport to main train station (Dworzec Warszawa Centralna) you have 3 options:

1. taxi (about 15 euro) - about 20-30 min. depending on traffic
2. public bus number 175 (bus stop in front of the terminal, tickets in vending machine next to a bus stop or in a kiosk) – about 20-30 min. depending on traffic
3. train – on the right from Arrivals follow yellow signs painted on the street – about 20 min.

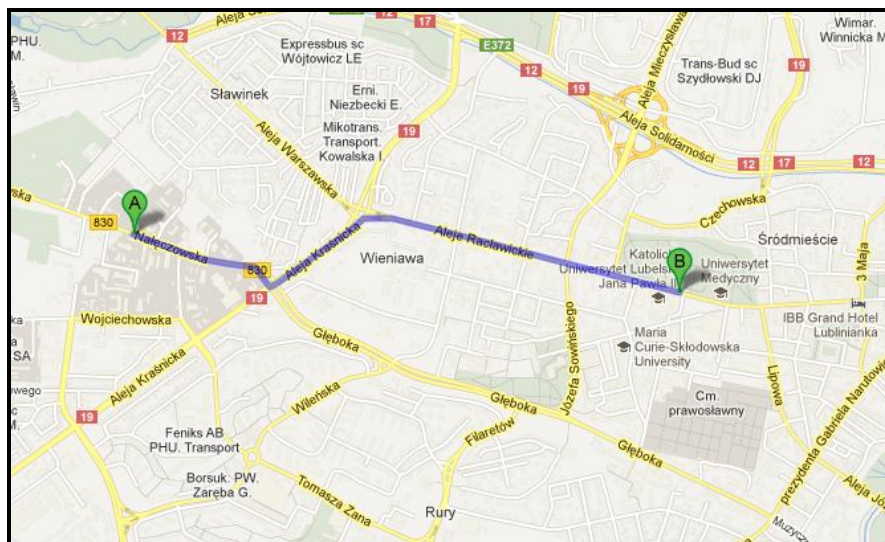
HOTEL MERCURE



Address: 12 Raławickie Avenue, 20-037 Lublin

The Mercure Lublin Unia Hotel is situated near to the main organizations, shopping center and a number of tourist attractions, such as the Old Town (0.9 miles), the Royal Palace in Lublin (1.2 miles), and the State Museum at Majdanek (5 miles). The hotel is perfect both for business travelers and those wanting to relax, offering 105 comfortable rooms, 5 apartments, a restaurant, Internet workstation and fitness center.

Point B – HOTEL MERCURE

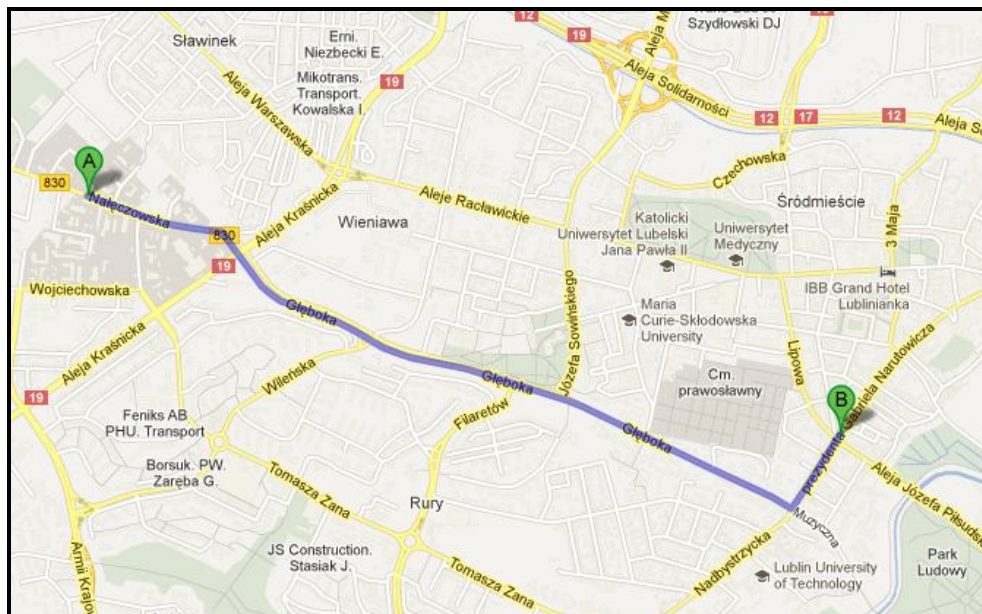
HOTEL VICTORIA



Address: 58/60 Narutowicza Street, 20-016 Lublin

The hotel is located in the city Centre, on the junction of five busy streets, with many shops and travel agencies around. It takes only some 15 minutes to walk to the main shopping street of Krakowskie Przedmieście and the Old Town, and even less to two theatres and the Lublin Plaza shopping and entertainment centre. The hotel is convenient for a number of trade and exhibition centres, sport grounds, the Ludowy Park, the railway station, and the path along the Bystrzyca River, which is great to jog along. It is easy to get to Victoria no matter from which direction you arrive, especially since the hotel towers above its surroundings and its restaurant dominates the junction it overlooks. There is a great view over the city from the upper floors.

LUBLIN CASTLE



Address: Ul. Zamkowa 9, 20-117 Lublin

The royal castle in Lublin, the Castle Romanesque tower, was built in the twelfth century. It was the site of numerous visits by the kings Kazimierz Wielki and the kings Władysław Jagiełło. For 128 years he was in prison. Today, it houses the Lublin Museum and the Chapel of the Holy Trinity.

The Museum's mission is to foster the development of memory and historical education of the German occupation of Lublin during World War II, particularly by commemorating the victims, protection of objects and documentation of the history of the Majdanek concentration camp and extermination camp at Belżcu.

VILLAGE MUSEUM IN LUBLIN

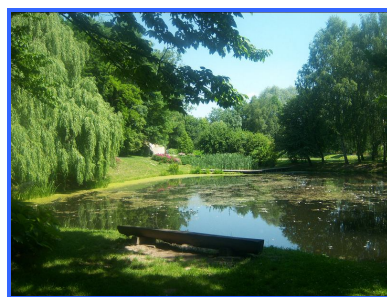
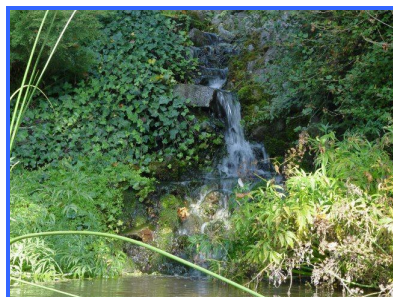


Address: Aleja Warszarska 96, 20-824 Lublin

Museum of the Lublin village collects wooden architecture, brick and ethnographic collections from the area of the former province of Lublin. It presents seven sets of thematic and geographical areas that reflect the lives of people in the early twentieth century, for example: forges, aviary, cottages and farmhouses, chapels and bell towers. Museum next to the permanent exhibitions organizes temporary exhibitions, events referring to the year ritual in the country, patriotic events, shows disappearing crafts, educational activities and other cultural events. In addition to exploring objects or walking on a charming site, you can use the local beer hall, which also serves Polish specialties: dumplings or bread with lard.

BOTANICAL GARDEN
